Doggie Day Camp

If your pet is socialized, and well mannered, drop them off with us for a day or romping around and making new friends. Your pup will be lovingly taken care of by our attentive staff while you're at work, play, or out shopping.



Q: How can I tell if my dog would like doggie daycare? A: Look at his personality. Does your dog enjoy the company of other dogs? Does your dog like to be around other dogs? Does your dog play with other dogs, and how well does your dog play with other dogs? Not all dogs are suitable for doggie daycare. It's a lot of activity and they need to be able to enjoy it. Some dogs are lower key. They like to just hang out with other dogs, but not necessarily play a lot. You have to know what level your dog is on.

Q: Should the dogs be separated by size? A: It's not just size, because small dogs and young puppies are the same size, but they're not appropriate players. So we would also look at the activity level, the play style of the dogs. Look at the size and also the dogs' personalities. For instance, Jack Russell terriers don't play well with little poodles, although they're roughly the same size.

Q: My doggie daycare wants to do a temperament test before allowing my dog in? Is that necessary? A: It's for the safety of both the dogs and the people. It helps to determine if the daycare is right for you and the dog. Again, not all dogs are suitable for daycare play. It's also used to match your dog's personality with appropriate playmates so your dog is placed in the correct playgroup.

Q: Are there some breeds that shouldn't be allowed in daycare? A: You really need to look at the dogs as individuals, not as breeds. We test all daycamp dogs with a 3 day evaluation for temperament and behavior issues. Any dog, regardless of breed, will not be allowed at daycamp if they do not pass our evaluation.

Q: What kind of training should the staff of a doggie daycare have? A: Doggie Day Camp is supervised by a Certified dog trainer along with qualified staff who have been trained in reading canine body language, signs of stress and basic animal care. Almost nothing a dog does is incidental or accidental. There's a lot being said by dogs and we don't see it, even in their overt behaviors.

Dog behavior or communication is complex in itself and then you throw the dynamics of a group in there and it makes it even more complex. People can learn so much just by watching dogs interact.

Q: Should all dogs in daycare have their shots? A: Yes, it is a requirement. Proof of up to date vaccinations are required prior to any dog participating in daycare.

Q. Do I get a discount on a dog wash if my dog is in day camp or obedience training? A. Yes. We can wash your dog while they are in daycamp and send them home smelling great. Discounted pricing is \$10 (small dogs), \$15 (medium size) and \$20 (large dogs).

Shampoodle of Clifton Park Doggie Daycare

Rules:

We want day camp to be a safe, healthy and fun place for dogs to play! The management reserves the right to refuse any dogs that may not be appropriate for daycare.

Rules for Dog Owners!

- 🐾 Hours of Operation- 7:00AM – 7:00PM
- 🐾 All dogs must be observed for temperament prior to being admitted to day camp.
- 🐾 Owners must complete the daycare application and sign releases before dog(s) can be participate in day camp.
- 🐾 Proof of vaccination is required prior to dogs starting day camp.
- 🐾 Dogs must be dropped off and picked up within the hours stated above.
- 🐾 Dogs must be on a leash at all times during drop off and pick up.
- 🐾 Shampoodle's Dog Wash does not have the extra staff to monitor your dog outside of the doggie day camp area on special request. All dogs are treated equally.
- 🐾 Absolutely no dogs who show aggression will be allowed in day camp.
- 🐾 All incidents will be recorded and brought to the owners attention immediately.
- 🐾 Shampoodle accepts dogs of all breeds. Acceptance is based on temperament.

Rules for Dogs!

- 🐾 All dogs must be a minimum of 12 weeks old prior to admission to day camp.
- 🐾 Puppies must have had at least one initial physical by their Veterinarian and their first set of vaccinations prior to admission (proof required).
- 🐾 All dogs must be current in all vaccines or have positive vaccine titers, and all documentation must be presented prior to daycare evaluation.
- 🐾 We highly recommend dogs being spayed or neutered after 6 months of age. If your dog is an unaltered female, Shampoodle will not assume responsibility for unplanned pregnancies.
- 🐾 In an effort to insure the safety of all parties- all dogs will have a daycare evaluation consisting of a 3 day evaluation period and if found appropriate for daycare. During the evaluation period the following will be considered:
 - / Temperament and social skills.
 - / Ability to play nicely in a large group
 - / Excessive territorial or aggressive barking
 - / Any problem with separation anxiety
 - / Food or toy aggression towards other dogs.

Our certified trainer will give owners a written evaluation with notations of any concerns and will follow up with owners to make sure any issues are resolved. Training can be done to help curb jumping, excessive barking, leash pulling and more.

How it Works at Shampoodle



Shampoodle has plenty of tubs and times available. Because we want everyone to be happy while "Shampoodling" we request that you call ahead and make a reservation. Walk-ins are always welcome, but there may be a short wait during busy days.

During the week you do not need to make a reservation. If you'd like to make a reservation on a weekend we will gladly hold a tub for you. Call 518-371-6600 in Clifton Park and 368-3260 in Delmar anytime. Someone should answer, but if not just leave a message and someone will get right back to you. You can also call the 522-0575 if your call is not returned in a timely manner. If it's an emergency, such as being skunked, special arrangements will be made.

Shampoodle's staff will escort you to a tub and show you how it works. Once you choose a tub and a ramp or a gated tub, you will be on your way to your ultimate dog bathing experience. You will be amazed at how easy and organized it can be. Each tub has everything you need for the complete bath, shampoo, towels, conditioner, and scrubby, ear and eye cleaner. There are combs, rakes, and brushes on hand for all kinds of fur. Someone is always there to help and to answer any questions you have. You and your furry friend will be pros in no time...and we are always here to help!

We Do it Bathing Service -

If you have things to do or would rather we do the washing, drop off your dirty dog and we'll have your stinky buddy washed, fluffed, and smellin' good in 1 hour or less. This includes nails.) (You are welcome to stay) By appointment only. Prices start at \$25 (depending on the size and breed of the pup). Puppies are \$15 – price will go up as the puppy grows. Reservations are required.
